## Advanced Vehicle Stabilization and Extrication Concepts and Applications for Heavy Vehicles

Participants will utilize multiple types of rescue equipment and techniques to mitigate these scenarios. Unlike other programs that focus strictly on tow trucks or single tool techniques, this course shows multiple ways to accomplish your extrication goals using what you carry on your rescue vehicles.
